GENERAL INFORMATION

COSTS

There are no tuition fees for EU students. All courses are funded by the Irish Government under the National Development Plan. Please contact the college for relevant course details.

An additional €200 government levy applies to all students. You are exempt from this fee if you hold a medical card that is in your own right or if you are dependent on a medical card holder.

MAINTENANCE GRANT SCHEME (SUSI)

The Department of Education and Skills provides a means-tested maintenance grant for learners attending full-time further education. Assistance and information regarding eligibility can be accessed through www.studentfinance.ie

BACK TO EDUCATION ALLOWANCE (BTEA)

The Back to Education Allowance (BTEA) is a scheme that can be accessed by those who are unemployed, lone parents, people with disabilities or those who are in receipt of a Department of Social Protection benefit.



FRAMEWORK OF QUALIFICATIONS


All awards delivered in Central College Limerick are QQI accredited. Awards are placed at Level 5 and 6 on the National Framework.

Quality and Qualifications Ireland was established on 6 November 2012 under the Qualifications and Quality Assurance (Education and Training) Act 2012. The Authority was created by an amalgamation of four bodies that have both awarding and quality assurance responsibilities: the Further Education and Training Awards Council (FETAC), the Higher Education and Training Awards Council (HETAC), the National Qualifications Authority of Ireland (NQAI) and the Irish Universities Quality Board (IUQB). The Authority has assumed all the functions of the four legacy bodies while also having responsibility for new or newly-statutory responsibilities in particular areas. PROGRESSION TO LIMERICK INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY

Central College Limerick has a local agreement in place with Limerick Institute of Technology, allowing learners an opportunity to directly progress from any CCL major award to any course in LIT. Students wishing to enter a Level 6 or Level 7 LIT course, will need to pass their Level 5 major award in CCL. Students wishing to enter a Level 8 course in LIT, will need to achieve at least 3 distinctions within their CCL major award. Applications are made through www.cao.ie
